

The Staff at Torborg Builders have put together a list of ideas to help you with your move-out Cleaning.

*These are options and ideas for you to use at your own discretion. Management is not saying you must use these options as your method of cleaning. It is up to each resident to be responsible for the cleaning of his or her rental unit.

- Mr. Clean Magic Erasers are a great product that can be found at Wal-Mart or Target etc. They are fairly inexpensive and have many uses such as:
 - Marks on closet, entry, and bedroom doors
 - Inside cabinets and drawers
 - Soap scum on shower walls and bathtubs
 - Light switches
 - Sides and inside of dishwasher
 - Polishing kitchen sinks and strainers.

Make sure to follow behind the damp eraser with a dry cloth to ensure no watermarks are left behind.

- Cleaning the oven can be a tough job. Menard's has a product called a Scour Stick (looks like a pumice stone and is located in the cleaning supplies section). This is an excellent tool for removing stuck on oven spots and dirty oven racks.
- When cleaning the cupboards and drawers, pay attention to the corners where debris hides. A vacuum with a hose works great!
- Light fixtures (kitchen, dining rm, bedroom and hallway) can be cleaned in the dishwasher on the light wash cycle. EASY!
- When cleaning windows, be sure to clean the outside of the lower window. This can be done by opening the window 2-3 inches and then pulling the 2 latches on the top corners.
- To clean under the stove, open the door and pull oven away from the wall. The refrigerator is on wheels, so it just rolls out to clean behind it.
